3.The Crown of Life (endure temptation)	
James1:12 "Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him." The Crown of Life is for those who endure temptation. Temptation is not sin; it's yielding to temptation that becomes sin. You are able to stand temptation, thus, you are able to receive the Crown of Life.

2 Timothy 4:8


