And it came to pass, when men began to	
multiply on the face of the earth, and	
daughters were born unto them,	
2 That the sons of God saw the	
daughters of men that they were fair;	
and they took them wives of all which	
they chose.	
3 And the Lord said, My spirit shall not	
always strive with man, for that he also is	
flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred	
and twenty years. 4 There were giants	
in the earth in those days; and also after

Nephilim were half angel and half	
human. They were the offspring of fallen	
angels. They were literally the spawn of	
Satan's angels.

We find the term	
'unclean spirit'

foul spirit, and familiar spirit.	
Luke 13:32 (NLT)	
Jesus replied, "Go tell that fox that I will	
keep on casting out demons and healing	
people today and tomorrow; and the	
third day I will accomplish my purpose".	



The first theory is that demons are fallen angels.	
The second theory is that demons are	
the disembodied spirits of a pre Adamic	
race.	
The third theory is that demons are the	
disembodied spirits of the Nephilim that	
were killed during the flood or who died	
during the flood.	
Matthew 12:43-45 (NIV)	
43:"When an evil spirit comes out of a	
man, it goes through arid places seeking	
rest and does not find it.	
44:Then it says, 'I will return to the house	
I left.' When it arrives, it finds the house	
unoccupied, swept clean and put in	
order.	
45:Then it goes and takes with it seven	
other spirits more wicked than itself, and	
they go in and live there. And the final	
condition of that man is worse than the	
first. That is how it will be with this	
wicked generation.".

The third theory. Demons are the disembodied spirits of the Nephilim, who were destroyed in the flood not only has Scriptural support as we study the teachings of Jesus, but it was also the accepted view among the Jews at the time of Jesus Christ.	
Hebrew word for demon at the time of Christ was TAMUNEFAL TAMU: one who is dead, or buried NEFAL Nephal is singular. Nephilim is plural. dead nephal.
