<p>Numbers 30: 2 (NKJV) If a man makes <u>a vow</u> to the LORD, or <u>swears an oath</u> to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.</p>	
<p>What is a vow? What is an oath?</p>	
<p>It hath been said, Whosoever shall put away his wife, let him give her a writing of divorcement: But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery. Matthew 5:31–32 (KJV)</p>	
<p>Mark 9:10 NKJV Jesus told us “Therefore, what God has joined together in marriage, let no man separate,</p>	
<p>Number one. The decision to either accept or reject Jesus Christ as your Lord and Saviour because you're choosing where you're going to spend eternity!</p>	
<p>Number two. Your career. What are you going to do with your life?</p>

<p>Matthew 19:3-10 3 The Pharisees also came to Him, testing Him, and saying to Him, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for just any reason?" 4 And He answered and said to them, "Have you not read that He who made them at the beginning 'made them male and female,' 5 and said, 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'? 6 So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate." 7 They said to Him, "Why then did Moses command to give a certificate of divorce, and to put her away?" 8 He said to them, "Moses, because of the hardness of your hearts, permitted you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so. 9 And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for (fornication), sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery." 10 His disciples said to Him, "If such is the case of the man with his wife, it is better not to marry."</p>	
<p>Matthew 19:3, "Is it lawful to divorce one's wife for any cause?"</p>	
<p>Deuteronomy 24:1-4 "When a man takes a wife and marries her, and it happens that she finds no favor in his eyes because he has found some uncleanness in her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce, puts it in her hand, and sends her out of his house, when she has departed from his house, and goes and becomes another man's wife, if the latter husband detests her and writes her a certificate of divorce, puts it in her hand, and sends her out of his house, or if the latter husband dies who took her as his wife, then her former husband who divorced her must not take her back to be his wife after she has been defiled; for that is an abomination before the Lord, and you shall not bring sin on the land which the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance.</p>

<p>Matthew 19:7-10 Jews replied 7 They said to Him, “Why then did Moses command to give a certificate of divorce, and to put her away?” 8 He said to them, “Moses, because of the hardness of your hearts, permitted you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so. 9 And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for (fornication),sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery.” 10 His disciples said to Him, “If such is the case of the man with his wife, it is better not to marry.”</p>	
<p>Malachi 2:16 “For I hate divorce!” says the Lord, the God of Israel. “To divorce your wife is to overwhelm her with cruelty,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies. “So guard your heart; do not be unfaithful to your wife.”</p>	
<p>Matthew 19:9 KJV And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery.</p>	
<p>Matthew 19: 9 NKJV And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery.”</p> <p>NKJV says... And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, NKJV (fornication KJV-Porneia) and marries another, commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery.”</p>	
<p>Fornication is translated from the Greek word for PORNEIA</p>

Adultery is translated from the Greek word moykhyoo-o -means to commit adultery	
Matthew 5:27 (NKJV) “You have heard that it was said to those of old, ‘You shall not commit adultery.’ But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.’	
God chose certain words. He chose PORNEIA fortification this word over that word, moykhyoo-o, adultery	
1 Timothy 5:8 (NKJV) But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.	
Titus 2:5 ⁵ <i>to be</i> discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.	
First Corinthians 7:5 ⁵ Do not deprive one another except with consent for a time, that you may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again so that Satan does not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.
