<p>Genesis 1:26 KJV And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.</p>	
<p>Jude 1:10 KJV But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.</p>	
<p>The first word is naturally translated from the Greek φ ukós {foo-see-koce}; and it literally means instinctively.</p>	
<p>The second word that Jude used to describe animal is brutal translated from the Greek word ...Brute ζroyos {al'-og-os}</p>	
<p>Third word that Jude used to describe animals was beast. Beast is translated from the Greek word. (dzo-on)</p>	
<p>Three theories of determinism taught by psychologists. First word is genetic determinism. Second is psychic determinism. Third is environmental determinism.</p>
