I was taught that the manifestation gifts <u>ceased at the end of the apostolic age.</u>	
Gifts listed in Romans chapter 12, are referred to as motivational gifts.	
<u>Nine Manifestation Gifts</u> 1. Word of wisdom. 2. Word of knowledge. 3. Gift of faith. 4. Gift of healings. 5. Miracles. 6. Prophecy. 7. Discerning of spirits. 8. Tongues. 9 Gift of interpretation of tongues.	
If you operate in the spiritual gifts, you must be spiritually mature. But the truth is, the <u>gifts are not a sign of spiritual maturity.</u>

<p>1Corinthians 1:7(KJV) So that <u>ye come behind in no gift</u>; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ:</p>	
<p>1 Corinthians 12:23 (NKJV)</p>	
<p>1 Corinthians 14:26 (NKJV)</p>	
<p>1Corinthians 1:11 (NKJV) For it has been declared to me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you.</p>	
<p>1 Corinthians 3:2–3 (NKJV) I fed you with milk and not with solid food; for until now you were not able to receive it, and even now you are still not able; for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men? You don't walk spiritual sense of God. You walk as me.</p>	
<p>The word carnal, is translated from the Greek word 'sarkikos' literally means fleshly.</p>

<p>The word gift in the Bible is translated from the Greek word charisma which is a compound word.</p>	
<p>Charisma is made up of two words. Transliteration: charis Pronunciation: khar'-ece</p>	
<p>1Corinthians 14:27 (NKJV) If anyone speaks in a tongue, let there be two or at the most three, each in turn, and let one interpret.</p>	
<p>1Corinthians 14:28 (NKJV) But if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God.</p>	
<p>1Corinthians 14:29 (NKJV) Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.</p>

<p>1Corinthians14:31 (NKJV) For you can all prophesy one by one, that all may learn and all may be encouraged.</p>	
<p>1Corinthians14:32 (NKJV) And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.</p>	
<p>1 Corinthians14:37 (NKJV) If anyone thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord.</p>	
<p>1Corinthians.14.38 (NKJV) But if any man be ignorant, let him be ignorant.</p>	
<p>1Corinthians14.23 -(NLT) Even so, if unbelievers or people who don't understand these things come into your meeting and hear everyone talking in an unknown language, they will think you are crazy</p>	
<p>1Corinthians14.32 (NLT) Remember that people who prophesy are in control of their spirit and can wait their turn.</p>

<p>1Corinthians 14:24 (NLT) But if all of you are prophesying, and unbelievers or people who don't understand these things come into your meeting, they will be convicted of sin, and they will be condemned by what you say.</p>	
<p>1Corinthians 14:25 (NLT) As they listen, their secret thoughts will be laid bare, and they will fall down on their knees and worship God, declaring, "God is really here among you."</p>
