The word carnal, is translated from the Greek word	
'sarkikos' literally means fleshly.	



The word gift in the Bible is translated from the Greek word charisma which is a compound word.	
Charisma is made up of two words. Transliteration: charis Pronunciation: khar'-ece	
1Corinthians 14:27 (NKJV) If anyone speaks in a tongue, let there be two or at the most three, each in turn, and let one interpret.	
1Corinthians14.28 (NKJV) But if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God.	
1Corinthians 14.29 (NKJV) Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.	





1Corinthians 14:24 (NLT) But if all of you are prophesying, and unbelievers or people who don't understand these things come into your meeting, they will be convicted of sin, and they will be condemned by what you say.
