<p>Last week we saw the true meaning of the Rapture! Called Har-pad -zo! Means to be caught up and came from the Latin word, 'Raptus' - snatched up.</p>	
<p>John 11:21-27 (NLT) Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if only you had been here, my brother would not have died. But even now I know that God will give you whatever you ask." Jesus told her, "Your brother will rise again." "Yes," Martha said, "he will rise when everyone else rises, at the last day."</p>	
<p>Jesus told her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying. Everyone who lives in me and believes in me will never ever die. Do you believe this, Martha?" "Yes, Lord," she told him. "I have always believed you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who has come into the world from God."</p>	
<p>So the two sisters sent a message to Jesus telling him, "Lord, your dear friend is very sick." John 11:3 (NLT)</p>	
<p>But when Jesus heard about it he said, "Lazarus's sickness will not end in death. No, it happened for the glory of God so that the Son of God will receive glory from this." So although Jesus loved Martha, Mary, and Lazarus, John 11:4-5</p>

<p>John 11:25-26 (NIV) 25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; 26 and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?"</p>	
<p>The words "resurrection" and "life" are not synonyms. (They don't mean the same thing)</p> <p>verse 25. Jesus told her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying.</p>	
<p>"I am" Greek "ego".</p>	
<p>. Verse 26... "Everyone who lives in me and believes in me will never ever die. Do you believe this, Martha?"</p>	
<p>He "shouts" Lazarus come forth.</p>	
<p>verse 26. And whosoever liveth and believeth in me, shall never die.</p>

<p>Hebrewism. A Jewish figure of speech.</p>	
<p>“To the age” “forever”</p>	
<p>“Don’t let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me. There is more than enough room in my Father’s home. John 14:1-3 (NLT)</p>	
<p>1 Corinthians 6:17 17 But whoever is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him.</p>	
<p>Marriage to them was a practical legal matter established by covenant. It began with what was called a ‘ketubah’. The ‘ketubah’ was like a prenuptial agreement, engagement except it is a moral legal contract.</p> <p>It was a covenant laying out the terms of the proposed marriage, and it included what was known as the ‘mohair’ which was the bridal price.</p>	
<p>After paying the mohair, the bridegroom would depart to his father's house, but before leaving he would say. I go to prepare a place for you.</p>

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<p>Matthew 1:19 (NLT) Joseph, to whom she was engaged, was a righteous man and did not want to disgrace her publicly, so he decided to break the engagement quietly.</p>	
<p>Mark 13:32 (KJV) “But that day in that hour, knoweth no man, no, not the angels, but you're in heaven, neither the son but the Father.”</p>	
<p>When the groom’s father said it was time, the groom would go out and assemble his friends to accompany him to claim his bride, and they normally set out at night to surprise the bride!</p>	
<p>1 Thessalonians 5:2 (NLT) For you know quite well that the day of the Lord’s return will come unexpectedly, like a thief in the night.</p>
