### Daniel 9:27 (NIV)

will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.' In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him."

Week in Hebrew means :- Transliteration: shâbûa' shâbûa' shebû'âh

Pronunciation: {shaw-boo')-means, 7 days, 7 months, or 7 years. In this case it means 7 years.

### The Seventy Weeks of Daniel a Summary.

- \* 9:24 70 weeks or 490 years required fulfill prophecy, deal with Israel's sin, etc.
- \* 9:25 the first 69 weeks or 483 years has two consecutive parts (7 weeks + 62 weeks)
- \* 9:26 an interval before last week kill Messiah, destroy city and Temple, land desolate.
- \* 9:27 the last week (final 7 years) 7-year covenant, rebuild Temple, war.

- 1. He puts an end to the sacrifice and offerings, which tells us that part of the conditions of this treaty.
- 2. Israel is allowed to rebuild the temple on the Temple Mount, and they're also allowed to reinstitute the sacrificial system.

# **Deuteronomy 16:16 (NLT)**

So from the time that decree was given, until the Messiah appears right here, he's revealed. This will be a period of 483 years or 173,880 days, that would be from this time to this time,


\* Jesus entered Jeruslem, April 6, 32AD.
