



Daniel 9:24 NLT

24 "Seventy 'sevens' are decreed for your people and your holy city to finish transgression, to put an end to sin, to atone for wickedness, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the Most Holy Place.

verse 25

"Know and understand this: From the time the word goes out to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until the Anointed One, the ruler, comes, there will be seven 'sevens,' and sixty-two 'sevens.' It will be rebuilt with streets and a trench, but in times of trouble.

verse 26 - 27

After the sixty-two 'sevens,' the Anointed One will be put to death and will have nothing. The people of the ruler who will come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end will come like a flood: War will continue until the end, and desolations have been decreed. 27 He will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.' In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him.

"The Lord said, "If as one people speaking the same language they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them.


The people who were building the Tower of Babel, were from the same ethnic group.

Caesar Augustus BC 63 - made some sweeping changes to solve the problem.



The first thing he did was he placed all of the Italian soldiers into an elite military unit called the Praetorian Guard.

Five legions were involved in the siege of Jerusalem, Legion five from Judea, which was made up of Arabs, Syrians, and Edomites. Legion 10. From Syria, made up of Syrians, Legion 15 from Syria, also made up of Syrians, Legion 12 from Asia Minor in Syria, which was made up of soldiers primarily from Syria and a few from what is now eastern Turkey and northern Iraq, and Legion three from Syria, which is also made up of serious as you can see, four of the legions were from Syria, and one was from Judea.
