



<p>Genesis 6:1-4 (NIV) 6 When human beings began to increase in number on the earth and daughters were born to them, 2 the sons of God saw that the daughters of humans were beautiful, and they married any of them they chose. 3 Then the Lord said, “My Spirit will not contend with humans forever, for they are mortal; their days will be a hundred and twenty years.” 4 The Nephilim were on the earth in those days—and also afterward—when the sons of God went to the daughters of humans and had children by them. They were the heroes of old men of renown. (Yet his day shall be 120 years).</p>	
<p>There were giants, in the original, it says Nephilim, on the earth in those days and also afterward.</p>	
<p>Genesis chapter 5 is the genealogy of Adam.</p>	
<p>Genesis 5:1-2 (KJV) This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him; 2 Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.</p>	
<p>Generations is translated from the Hebrew word to Hebrew: תלדה תולדה Transliteration: tōledâh tōledâh Pronunciation: {to-led-aw'} to-led-aw'</p>	

Genesis 6:1-4 Explains how and why people became so wicked.

Genesis 6:5-8 We are told why God had to destroy the super race of people and everyone else on the planet.

Genesis 6:1-4 Begins the genealogy of Noah

Genesis 6:1-4 (KJV)

And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them,

² That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

And the Lord said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

⁴ There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

<p>Genesis 1:6 “Now it came to pass when men began to multiply on the face of the earth and daughters were born to them.</p>	
<p>Adam and Eve were perfect specimens before the fall.</p>	
<p>Genesis 3:14 And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:</p>	
<p>Thistles in the Hebrew means mutations. Hebrew dar-dar'</p>	
<p>Genesis 3:18 Thorns also and thistles (Mutation) shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field;</p>	
<p>That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; (<i>beautiful – Hebrew ‘tobe’</i>)<u>and they took them wives of all which they chose. Genesis 6:2 (KJV)</u></p>	

<p>Genesis 6:1-2 “that the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were <u>beautiful people</u>”.</p>	
<p>“and they took them wives of all which they chose.”</p>	
<p>Hebrew: נְשִׁים אֲשֵׁר Transliteration: 'ishshâh nâshîym Pronunciation: {ish-shaw'} naw-sheem' Definition: The first form is the feminine</p>	
<p>Hebrew word is ish-shaw, which refers to a woman, regardless of whether she is married or not.</p>	
<p>The word <i>took</i> is translated from the Hebrew word law-kakh Hebrew: לקח Transliteration: lâqach Pronunciation: law-kakh'</p>	
<p>Genesis 6:2 That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took (sexual euphemism) them WOMEN (wives) of all which they chose</p>	
<p>Who are the sons of God?</p>	
<p>Number 1 One theory says that they're fallen angels.</p>	

<p>Number 2 Another theory says that their royalty</p>	
<p>Number 3 The third theory says that the sons of God are the descendants of Seth. (Seth represents the godly line and Cain represents the ungodly line.)</p>	
<p>Hermeneutics is defined</p> <p>“As the science and art of interpreting the Bible. It's considered a science because it has rules, and these rules can be classified into an orderly system”.</p>	
<p>SONS OF GOD' IS USED FIVE TIMES IN THE OLD TESTAMENT.</p>	
<p>Genesis chapter six, verse two. Three times in the book of Job, once in the book of Daniel. Four times plus in Genesis</p>	
<p>Job 2:1</p> <p>“It says again, there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord now, how many of you read the King James Version?”</p>	
<p>Job 38:4-7 (KJV)</p> <p>⁴ Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.</p> <p>⁵ Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it?</p> <p>⁶ Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof;</p> <p>⁷ When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?</p>	

<p>⁴ Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth?</p> <p>7. When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?</p>	
<p>Which was the son of Enos, which was the son of Seth, which was the son of Adam, which was the son of God. Luke 3:38 KJV</p>	
<p>The phrase sons of God refer to those who are created by God rather than being born.</p>	
<p>John 1:12 (KJV) But as many as received Him, Jesus, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe in his name, whose name Jesus name.</p>	
<p>How can we be called sons of God?</p>	
<p>2 Corinthians 5:17 “Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, in other words, anyone's accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior.</p>	
<p>We know it is referring to Fallen Angels, because God never created angels to have sex, and to do so was even further rebellion against God.</p>	
<p>Mark 12:25 NLT. “For when the dead rise, they will neither marry nor be given in marriage, in this respect they will be like angels in heaven”.</p>	

<p>Jude 1:6 (NLT) “And I remind you of the angels who did not stay within the limits of authority God gave them. They stepped out of their authority that God had given them but left the place where they belonged.</p>	
<p>1 Peter 2:4 “For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered to them into chains of darkness, to be reserved into judgment.</p>	
<p>Hebrews 13:2 (NLT) “Don't forget to show hospitality to strangers. For some who have done this have entertained angels”.</p>	
<p>That evening the two angels came to the entrance of the city of Sodom. Lot was sitting there, and when he saw them, he stood up to meet them. Then he welcomed them and bowed with his face to the ground. 2 “My lords,” he said, “come to my home to wash your feet, and be my guests for the night. You may then get up early in the morning and be on your way again.” “Oh no”, they replied. “We'll just spend the night out here in the city square.” 3 But Lot insisted, so at last they went home with him. Lot prepared a feast for them, complete with fresh bread made without yeast, and they ate. 4 But before they retired for the night, all the men of Sodom, young and old, came from all over the city and surrounded the house. 5 They shouted to Lot, “Where are the men who came to spend the night with you?
