We are cleansed by His blood.

The blood represents Jesus's sacrificial death.

Leviticus 17:11 (NLT)

For the life of the body is in its blood. I have given you the blood on the altar to purify you, making you right with the Lord. It is the blood, given in exchange for a life, that makes purification possible.

The blood represents life.

When blood is poured out on the altar, it represents a life being taken.

John 18:36 (NIV)

Jesus said, "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place."

John 18:38 (NIV)

"What is truth?" retorted Pilate. With this he went out again to the Jews gathered there and said, "I find no basis for a charge against him."

Zechariah 13:6 (NIV)

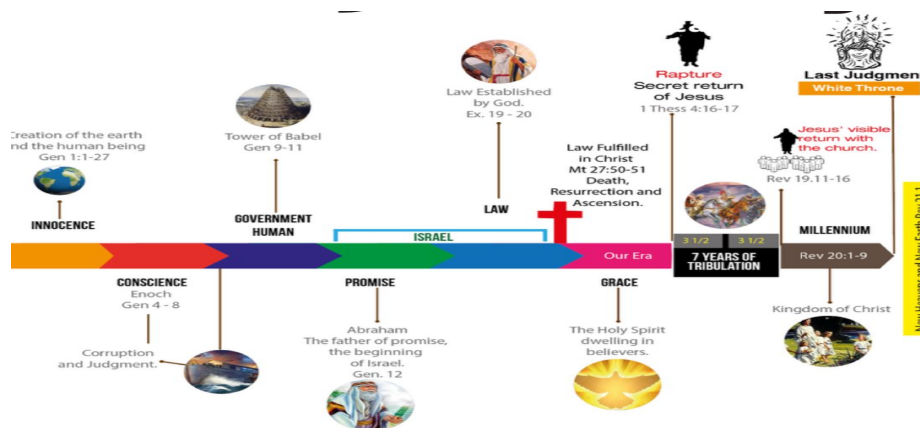

2. Fullness of Gentiles & Time of the Gentiles.

9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

At that time, the focus was taken off the church, and the focus is on who? The Jews.

The Book of Revelation '144,000' refers to a specific group of people described as being sealed and redeemed, often interpreted as representing a group of faithful believers who will rule with Christ in Heaven.

When Christ returns, all of Israel will be saved, for they will see Jesus was the Messiah.
Zechariah chapter 12 verse 9 to chapter 13 verse 1.
Romans chapter 11 verse 25 - 27 is talking about the fullness of the Gentiles.

Jewish phrase that denotes
"Gentile domination"

This began in Babylonian captivity and happened because of Israel's disobedience.

Luke 21:24 (NLT)

They will be killed by the sword or sent away as captives to all the nations of the world. And Jerusalem will be trampled down by the Gentiles until the period of the Gentiles comes to an end.

When Jesus returns, He is the King of kings and Lord of Lords. He will rule over all kings, there will no longer be Gentile domination.

There is a curse that will come upon the nation who does not bless and serve God.

3. All nations, not just Israel, will mourn over Him. Every nation will know that Jesus Christ is the Messiah.

Philippians 2:9–11 (KJV)

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father

Colossians. 1:15-16 (NIV)
